



Parcours rules

As in any kind of sport, there are also Rules for archery. These must be followed to enable a safe running.



1. REGISTRATION

The registration is essential. PLEASE NEVER ENTER THE PARCOURS WITHOUT REGISTRATION. **DANGER OF LIFE.** The registration and rental of equipment is located at the Hotel Hintertuxerhof.

2. SIGNS IN PARCOURS

Our parcours is marked with several wooden signs. Each station has two starting points which are marked with wooden stakes (green=beginner, red=advanced). Due to security reasons it is not allowed to choose any other starting point. Furthermore it is also not allowed to run the parcours in the opposite direction or to take a shortcut. Please make sure that there is always just one person that shoots. Take care that there are no persons or animals in the target range. Branches, twigs, leaves etc. are part of the parcours. Please do not replace.

3. COMPENSATION CLAIM

There is no compensation claim for lost or damaged arrows, bows and any other material.

4. GET THE ARROWS

By pulling out the arrows of the 3D animals please push one hand against the animal in order to keep it into the anchoring. If you should find an animal which is damaged or loosely please let us know. In case you are searching arrows behind one of the animals please warn the following archers by placing the bow directly in front of the animal or by one person waiting at the starting points. Found arrows are not the property of the finder and must be submitted to the Hotel Hintertuxerhof. For these arrows you will get a voucher.

5. SECURITY

Our parcours is marked with warning signs for hiker and walker. In case you would meet someone within the parcours please tell them to use the marked and safe hiking paths.

Please pay attention that each archer is responsible for each shot and liable for it.

Parents are responsible for their children. The usage of compound bows and crossbows isn't allowed by authority!

6. NATURE

Dogs are allowed but have to be kept on a leash. Please take care of nature and animals. Do not smoke and don't scream around. Take your waste and damaged arrows with you.

7. END OF PARCOURS

As soon as the dawn begins you have to stop the archery and leave the parcours in the marked direction, no matter if you have already shot on all animals.
